### The Award

The three finalists will be invited to the IHM Scotland Annual Conference Awards dinner on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2010, at which Scotland's Top Healthcare Manager 2010 will be presented with an Award. In addition to the Award, the winner will also receive a year's complementary membership of the Institute with all the benefits which that entails.

The winner and runners-up will also be featured in 'Health and Care Management', with articles illustrating best practice case studies based on their nominations.

### **Eligibility**

This Award is open to all staff in managerial and leadership positions employed within the NHS in Scotland, to all Practice Managers in Scotland and to all other managers working exclusively within healthcare services and practising in Scotland.

### **Nomination**

Anyone can nominate a Manager for this Award.

There is no set nomination form, but judges must be able to clearly discern the information described on the preceding page in sufficient detail from the initial submission to aid their proper consideration.

In addition to submitting evidence in support of their nominee, nominators should also provide their own name and contact details and how, and in what capacity they know the person they are nominating.
